Meet: K-Mart parking lot behind/West of  
Chevron Gas Station

Time: Sunrise Blvd & Zinfandel  
9 am; Clutches out at 9:30 am

Length: approx 2 ½ hours, maybe 95  
miles - one way

Route:

L – out of parking lot on to Zinfandel

R – Sunrise Blvd

L – White Rock Rd

R – Grant Line Rd

L – Hwy 16

R – Willow Creek Rd

L – Hwy 104 (also Preston Ave)

L – Main Street

R – Hwy 124 (S. Church St)

L – Buena Vista Rd

Cross over Hwy 88

Road splits at Coal Mine Rd; vere L to stay on  
Buena Vista Rd

Stay on Buena Vista Rd until it changes names to  
S. Camanche Pkwy

Continue on Camanche Pkwy S, veering R @ Chili  
Camp Rd

L – Burson Rd where Camanche Pkwy ends at a  
“T”

L – onto Hwy 12

@ town of Valley Springs where Hwy 12 & Hwy  
26 connect, there’s a grocery store with a large  
parking lot if someone needs a pit stop. Li’l over  
half-way.

R – Hwy 26

L – Jenny Lind Rd (if ya get to Oak Grove, you’ve  
gone too far)

Same road turns into Milton Rd and continues  
Southbound. Slow curves.

Veer R @ Hunt Rd through the small town of  
Milton

Cross Hwy 4 and Pass Dunton Rd

L - E. Sonora Rd to the town of Eugene

Pass 28-Mile Rd

Continue (a longer stretch) on Sonora Rd

Sonora Rd comes to a "T" @ Orange Blossom Rd

L – then it becomes Sonora Rd again and approaches the town of Knights Ferry

Slow for a hard left curve through town then jog R to continue on Sonora Rd

Sonora Rd ends @ Kennedy Rd where you'll see the 50s ROADHOUSE pkg lot

\* F.Y.I. \* Kennedy parallel's Hwy 120/108  
Gas can be found in the town of Oakdale, just a few miles West

#### OPTIONS FOR GETTING HOME AFTER LUNCH:

1. Can go R onto 108/120 toward Manteca and catch Hwy 99 North
2. Can go L onto 108/120 toward Sonora and take Hwy 49 toward Plymouth
