



July 8, 2006 Quincy

Meet at the Chevron Gas station at the intersection of Hwy 20 and Marysville Road at 8:30 am. Clutches out at 9 am

Phone number at the Chevron: 530-741-3663 Please call if you need to contact us before we leave.

Route:

West on Hwy 20 5.8 miles to Woodruff Road. Turn Right (about 3 or so miles down Woodruff there will be a sharp right hand turn. Turn right and stay on Woodruff.)

at 11.3 miles, Right on Hwy 70.

If we have anyone who cannot go 120 miles before getting gas, we will stop in Oroville at 35 miles for them to top up their tanks.

Continue on Hwy 70 up the Feather River Canyon

at approx 75 miles, there is a rest stop on the left, just before Belden. We can take a break there and regroup.

Hwy 70 into Quincy, 40 miles.

We will have lunch at the Quincy Cafe on Hwy 70. It is on the right just as you are leaving town.

They have breakfast and lunch, prices are under \$10. Phone is 530-283-0591

Gas Station is beside the Quincy Cafe. After lunch, gas up here.

Right out of gas station onto Hwy 70

Right on LaPorte Road, 3 miles

LaPorte Road into La Porte, 30 miles (about 2 miles before La Porte, you will come to a T-intersection. Turn Left for La Porte. It is clearly marked.

Break in La Porte to regroup.

Right on La Porte Road

Turns into Willow Glen at approx 30 miles

Turns into Marysville Road about 8 miles after that.

Gas up at Chevron at Hwy 20 and Marysville Road, approx 10 miles

I am rating this a 5 because of curves and road conditions. Hwy 70 and Hwy 20 are fine but La Porte Road can be a bit tricky. The first half has sand and gravel on some of the very sharp turns. The 2nd half is beautiful, freshly paved road.

Remember to ride at your own pace. We will regroup a couple of times and I will be taking it easy. So enjoy the day!
